On June 8th, 2024, over 80 people filled the lower Scott Hall to commemorate the 50th anniversary of Unit 6. The gathering on June 8th was a successful and joyous event, resembling a reunion for many who travelled from various parts of Ontario and Quebec to attend. The displays drew attention to the women who forged the path of the UCW Units at Lennoxville United Church since 1878. The photos were enjoyed, as they brought the spirit to life as guests reminisced. The gracious presence of two of Gertrude Scott's grandchildren and their spouses, who appreciated the attention and respectful tribute attributed to their grandmother, allowed many to exchange about Mrs. Scott and the infamous time capsule that is in the cornerstone of the Scott Hall.

Inniversary Celebrations

The actual date of the anniversary was October 8, 2023, but the decision to postpone this milestone celebration was to allow for more in-depth research of all Units and the beginnings of our UCW. This process began in November 2023 with Wendy Mason and Bev Oakley who sifted through archives and began contacting former members of the various UCW Units. This project would evolve into forming a committee to help piece together the stories and photos of the past. In doing this research, it was ultimately decided that the chapters of the past and present should be displayed at the Anniversary celebration for everyone to see and that a souvenir booklet would keep this celebration accessible and reminiscent for everyone. This notion would materialize, and the booklet became a 50-page 81/2 x 11 book containing precious snippets of history, photos, and stories about the past that includes the Gertrude Scott story, who donated the Scott Hall in 1939. Everyone who attended the event on June 8th, was greeted by Vi Mackey who gave each guest the official UCW pin and guests were given a copy of the book to take home following the various speeches and tributes.
