*Ephesians 1:7-14*

**7** In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace **8** that he lavished on us. With all wisdom and insight **9** he has made known to us the mystery of his will, according to his good pleasure that he set forth in Christ, **10** as a plan for the fullness of time, to gather up all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth. **11** In Christ we have also obtained an inheritance, having been destined according to the purpose of him who accomplishes all things according to his counsel and will, **12** so that we, who were the first to set our hope on Christ, might live for the praise of his glory. **13** In him you also, when you had heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and had believed in him, were marked with the seal of the promised Holy Spirit; **14** this is the pledge of our inheritance toward redemption as God's own people, to the praise of his glory.

## **Lectures de la Bible**

*Éphésiens 1:7-14*

7 Car, par le sacrifice du Christ, nous sommes délivrés du mal et nos péchés sont pardonnés. Dieu nous a ainsi manifesté la richesse de sa grâce, 8 qu'il nous a accordée avec abondance en nous procurant une pleine sagesse et une pleine intelligence: 9 Il nous a fait connaître son plan secret que, dans sa bienveillance, il avait décidé par avance de réaliser par le Christ. 10 Ce plan, que Dieu achèvera à la fin des temps, consiste à réunir tout ce qui est dans les cieux et sur la terre sous un seul chef, le Christ.

11 Dans notre union avec le Christ, nous avons reçu la part qui nous était promise, car Dieu nous avait choisis par avance, selon son plan; et Dieu réalise toutes choses conformément à ce qu'il a décidé et voulu. 12 Louons donc la grandeur de Dieu, nous qui avons été les premiers à mettre notre espoir dans le Christ!

13 Vous aussi, quand vous avez écouté le message de la vérité, la Bonne Nouvelle qui vous a apporté le salut, vous avez cru au Christ; alors, Dieu a mis sa marque personnelle sur vous, en vous donnant le Saint-Esprit promis. 14 Le Saint-Esprit nous garantit les biens que Dieu a réservés à son peuple; il nous assure que nous les posséderons quand notre délivrance sera complète. Louons donc la grandeur de Dieu.

## **Scripture readings (cont.)**

*Mark 6:14-29*

Now King Herod heard about all this, because Jesus' reputation had spread everywhere. Some people were saying, "John the Baptist has come back to life! That is why he has this power to perform miracles."

Others, however, said, "He is Elijah."

Others said, "He is a prophet, like one of the prophets of long ago."

When Herod heard it, he said, "He is John the Baptist! I had his head cut off, but he has come back to life!" Herod himself had ordered John's arrest, and he had him tied up and put in prison. Herod did this because of Herodias, whom he had married, even though she was the wife of his brother Philip. John the Baptist kept telling Herod, "It isn't right for you to marry your brother's wife!"

So Herodias held a grudge against John and wanted to kill him, but she could not because of Herod. Herod was afraid of John because he knew that John was a good and holy man, and so he

kept him safe. He liked to listen to him, even though he became greatly disturbed every time he heard him.

Finally Herodias got her chance. It was on Herod's birthday, when he gave a feast for all the top government officials, the military chiefs, and the leading citizens of Galilee. The daughter of Herodias came in and danced, and pleased Herod and his guests. So the king said to the girl, "What would you like to have? I will give you anything you want." With many vows he said to her, "I swear that I will give you anything you ask for, even as much as half my kingdom!"

So the girl went out and asked her mother, "What shall I ask for?"

"The head of John the Baptist," she answered.

The girl hurried back at once to the king and demanded, "I want you to give me here and now the head of John the Baptist on a plate!"

This made the king very sad, but he could not refuse her because of the vows he had made in front of all his guests. So he sent off a guard at once with orders to bring John's head. The guard left, went to the prison, and cut John's head off; then he brought it on a plate and gave it to the girl, who gave it to her mother. When John's disciples heard about this, they came and got his body, and buried it.

## Lectures de la Bible (cont.)

*Marc 6:14-29*

Or, le roi Hérode entendit parler de Jésus, car sa réputation s'était répandue partout. Certains disaient: «Jean-Baptiste est revenu d'entre les morts! C'est pourquoi il a le pouvoir de faire des miracles.» Mais d'autres disaient: «C'est Élie.» D'autres encore disaient: «C'est un prophète, pareil à l'un des prophètes d'autrefois.» Quand Hérode entendit tout ce qui se racontait, il se dit: «C'est Jean-Baptiste! Je lui ai fait couper la tête, mais il est revenu à la vie!»

En effet, Hérode avait donné l'ordre d'arrêter Jean et de le jeter en prison, enchaîné. C'était à cause d'Hérodiade, qu'Hérode avait épousée bien qu'elle fût la femme de son frère Philippe. Car Jean disait à Hérode: «Il ne t'est pas permis de prendre la femme de ton frère!» Hérodiade était remplie de haine contre Jean et voulait le faire exécuter, mais elle ne le pouvait pas. En effet, Hérode craignait Jean, car il savait que c'était un homme juste et saint, et il le protégeait. Quand il l'écoutait, il était très embarrassé; pourtant il aimait l'écouter. Cependant, une occasion favorable se présenta pour Hérodiade le jour de l'anniversaire d'Hérode. Celui-ci donna un banquet aux membres de son gouvernement, aux chefs de l'armée et aux notables de Galilée. La fille d'Hérodiade entra dans la salle et dansa; elle plut à Hérode et à ses invités. Le roi dit alors à la jeune fille: «Demande-moi ce que tu voudras, et je te le donnerai.» Et il lui fit ce serment solennel: «Je jure de te donner ce que tu demanderas, même la moitié de mon royaume.» La jeune fille sortit et dit à sa mère: «Que dois-je demander?» Celle-ci répondit: «La tête de Jean-Baptiste.» La jeune fille se hâta de retourner auprès du roi et lui fit cette demande: «Je veux que tu me donnes tout de suite la tête de Jean-Baptiste sur un plat!» Le roi devint tout triste; mais il ne voulut pas lui opposer un refus, à cause des serments qu'il avait faits devant ses invités. Il envoya donc immédiatement un soldat de sa garde, avec l'ordre d'apporter la tête de Jean-Baptiste. Le soldat se rendit à la prison et coupa la tête de Jean. Puis il apporta la tête sur un plat et la donna à la jeune fille, et celle-ci la donna à sa mère. Quand les disciples de Jean apprirent la nouvelle, ils vinrent prendre son corps et le mirent dans un tombeau.
